

ReactTime® Championship System Software Release Notes

This document describes the features of the newest version of the ReactTime Championship Software v1.30 not described in your *ReactTime Operator's Manual*.

Save event as a false start

You can now save a currently loaded event as a false start by choosing File | Save as False Start... The file name is appended with -FSx, where x is the number for the current event.

You can also use the shortcut CTRL + F to save the file as a false start.

Choose a common scale

By default, an option called "Maintain Scale Across Traces" is checked. This keeps the X-axis of the chart at the same scale for every trace you open. You can uncheck this box by clicking Chart | Options if you want to have the ability to change the scale for every trace you open.

Download trace data and reaction times separately

There are now two separate icons allowing you to download trace data and reaction times separately.



Click this icon to add reaction times to the event you have open.



Click this icon to download traces and add them to the event you have open.

New shortcut keys

- To export a bitmap, press CTRL + E.
- To add reaction times, press CTRL + R..
- To download traces, press CTRL + T.

Send reaction times to a scoreboard

Scoreboard support has been added to the ReactTime Championship software. Click Scoreboard | Options from the menu bar to configure ReactTime to be sent to a scoreboard.
